- Dual credit means the student has the option to earn college credit along with high school credit for this course.
- The college credit is College Algebra (5 credit hours) awarded through Marshall University and is transferrable to most other colleges and universities.
- Students must meet eligibility requirements set by Marshall University to enroll for college credit. Those requirements are an ACT Math Subject Score of 19 and a cumulative GPA of 3.0. Only juniors and seniors can enroll for college credit.
- There is a fee of \$125 (\$25 per credit hour) for this course. Checks should be made payable to Elkins High School.

Pre – Calculus Course Description: The course objectives extend students' knowledge of functions and equations, including higher – order functions, exponential and logarithmic functions, as well as provide preparation for calculus. Available technology is used to investigate functions and to enhance learning.

Math 127 Marshall University Course Description: A brief but careful review of the main techniques of algebra. Polynomial, rational, exponential, and logarithmic functions. Graphs, equations and inequalities, sequences.

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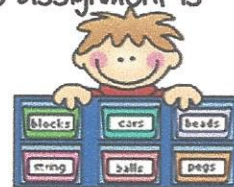
ATTENDANCE
